GENERAL INFORMATION

Hospital Visiting Hours

Regular visiting hours are 11 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Only two visitors are permitted per bedside. We also request that visitors in ICUs be limited to immediate family, significant others and clergy.

Children under 14 must be with an adult at all times. Children under 14 are not allowed in the ICUs or ICU waiting rooms or in the 8 North bone marrow transplant unit without prior approval from the unit nurse manager, hospital nursing supervisor or the patient's physician.

When you arrive at the hospital, representatives at the Guest Services Desk, located in the first floor lobby, can give you the location of a patient's room. If the Guest Services Desk is closed, you can get information about a patient's room in the Emergency Department on the 2nd floor of the hospital.

Overnights in the Hospital

Visitors are not allowed in the hospital after 9 p.m. If you have a special reason to be in the hospital past this time, please speak with the unit nurse manager or a hospital nursing supervisor. Visitors arriving at the hospital between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. must enter through the Emergency Department and receive authorization from the Protective Services officer on duty.

Cell Phones

We discourage the use of cell phones by patients and visitors.

Hotels and Other Places to Stay

Patients' family members who need a place to stay have more than one option:

- The Saint Louis University Hospital Auxiliary Hospitality House is located one block north of the hospital and provides a comfortable, affordable place to stay for families of patients who are from out of town. For information about the cost and availability of these rooms, please call (314) 268-5350 on weekdays between 7:30 a.m. and 10:30 p.m. and on weekends between 9 a.m. and 10:30 p.m. On holidays and after hours, please call Protective Services at (314) 577-8078.

You can get lower rates for some local hotels or make arrangements to stay in an apartment by calling the Guest Services Department at (314) 577-8500 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. After hours, this information is available from the Admitting or Emergency departments.

Meals and Snacks

The hospital cafeteria is located on the first floor around the corner from the lobby. Hot food is served from 1 a.m. to 3 a.m. and 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Vending machines are available 24 hours a day.

Smoking

Because of our concern for the health and safety of our patients, visitors and employees, smoking is not allowed in Saint Louis University Hospital.

Parking

Saint Louis University Hospital patients and visitors are welcome to park in the garage on Vista Avenue directly across from the hospital. The garage has a walkway to the hospital lobby. Daily visitor parking is available in the garage at a rate of 50 cents an hour.

A special discounted rate is available for patients and families by inquiring at the Guest Services desk in the hospital lobby. Valet parking is available at the hospital entrance on Vista Avenue from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Friday at a cost of \$3 per day. Other parking is available at on-street meters throughout the hospital campus.

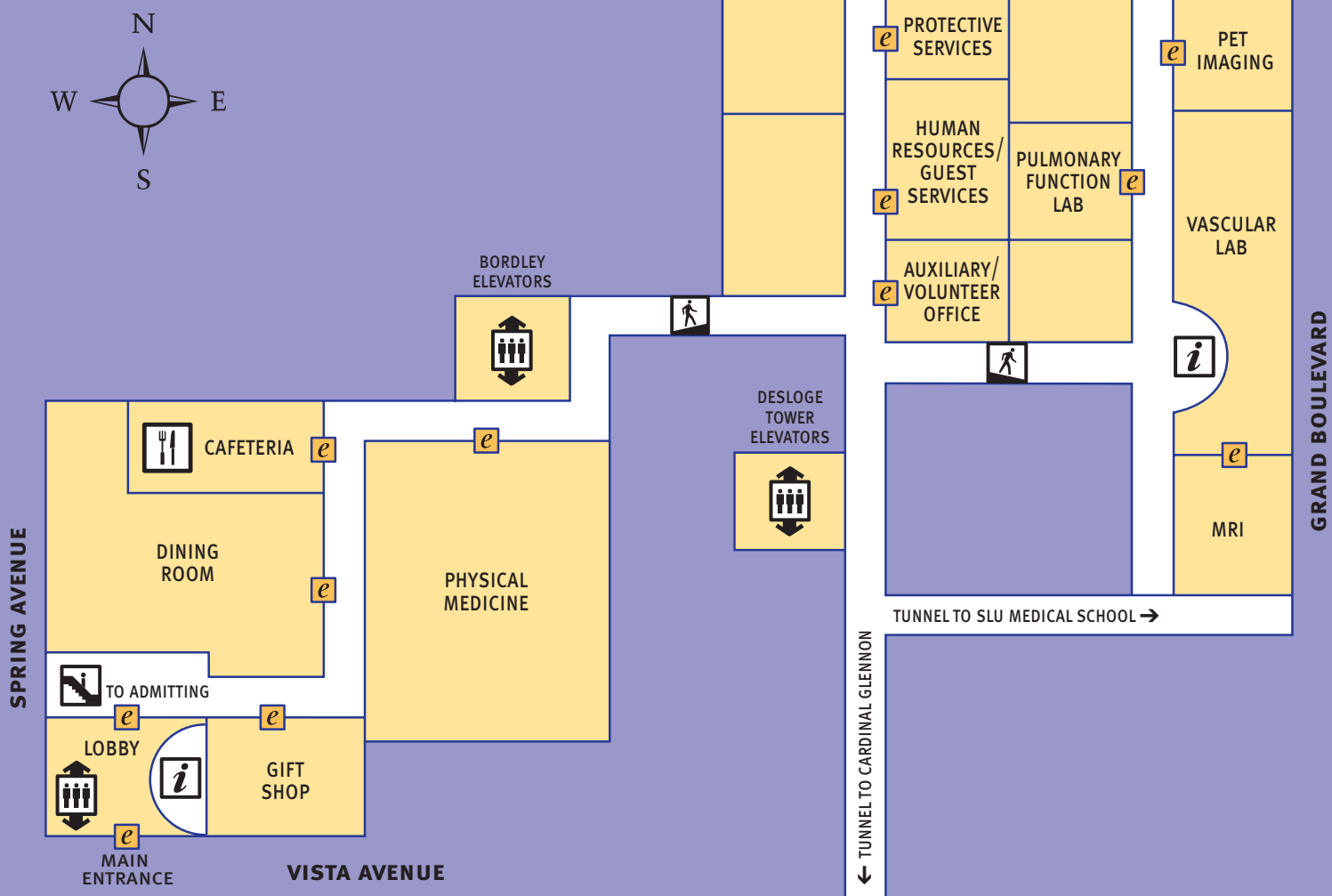

Admitting Lab Testing

Procedures performed: blood tests, EKG, electrocardiogram
 See 2nd floor map.

Angiography

Procedures performed: angiography, DEXA scans, PICC lines
 See 2nd floor map. To waiting area: Take Desloge Tower elevators to the 2nd floor. Turn right. Take the first left. Follow the signs to registration.

Ambulatory Care Unit (ACU)

Procedures performed: outpatient surgery and recovery
 Take the Bordley elevators to the 3rd floor. Turn right, then left, then right. The ACU office is straight ahead.

Apheresis (also known as Blood Collection Services, Blood Donation Services)

Procedures performed: blood donation, stem cell collection
 Take the Desloge Tower elevators to the 6th floor. Turn right. The Apheresis office is straight ahead.

Breast Imaging Center

Procedures performed: diagnostic and screening mammography, stereotactic biopsy ultrasound-guided biopsy, ultrasound
 First floor, Cancer Center, no. 17, campus map.

Bronchoscopy

Take the Bordley elevators to the 3rd floor. Turn right, then left, then right. Bronchoscopy is straight ahead.

Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory (also known as Heart Catheterization Laboratory)

To lab: Take the Desloge Tower elevators to the 13th floor. Turn left. The Cardiac Catheterization Lab is through the double doors. To waiting area: Take the Bordley elevators to the 13th floor. Take two lefts. The waiting area is on the right.

Computerized Tomography (CT) Scan/Special Procedures

See 2nd floor map. To waiting area: Take Desloge Tower elevators to the 2nd floor. Turn right. Take the first left. Follow the signs to registration.

Diagnostic Radiology

Procedures performed: arthrography, barium enema, barium swallow (esophagram), bony diagnostic radiographs, chest X-rays, cystogram, epidural injection, feeding tube placement, intravenous pyelogram, MBS, modified barium swallow, myelography, T-tube cholangiogram, upper GI.
 See 2nd floor map. To waiting area: Take Bordley elevators to the second floor. Turn right, then left, then right. Waiting area is on the right.

Echocardiography Laboratory (also known as Stress Testing)

Procedures performed: contrast echocardiogram, DSE (dobutamine stress echo), echocardiogram, exercise stress

echocardiogram, stress echocardiogram, surface echocardiogram, TEE (transesophageal echocardiogram), TTE (transthoracic echocardiogram), ultrasound of the heart

To lab: Take the Desloge Tower elevators to the 14th floor. Turn left. The Echocardiography Lab is through the double doors. To waiting area: Take the Desloge Tower elevators to the 14th floor. Turn right to waiting area.

Electroencephalography Laboratory (also known as EEG, EMG, Neurophysiology)

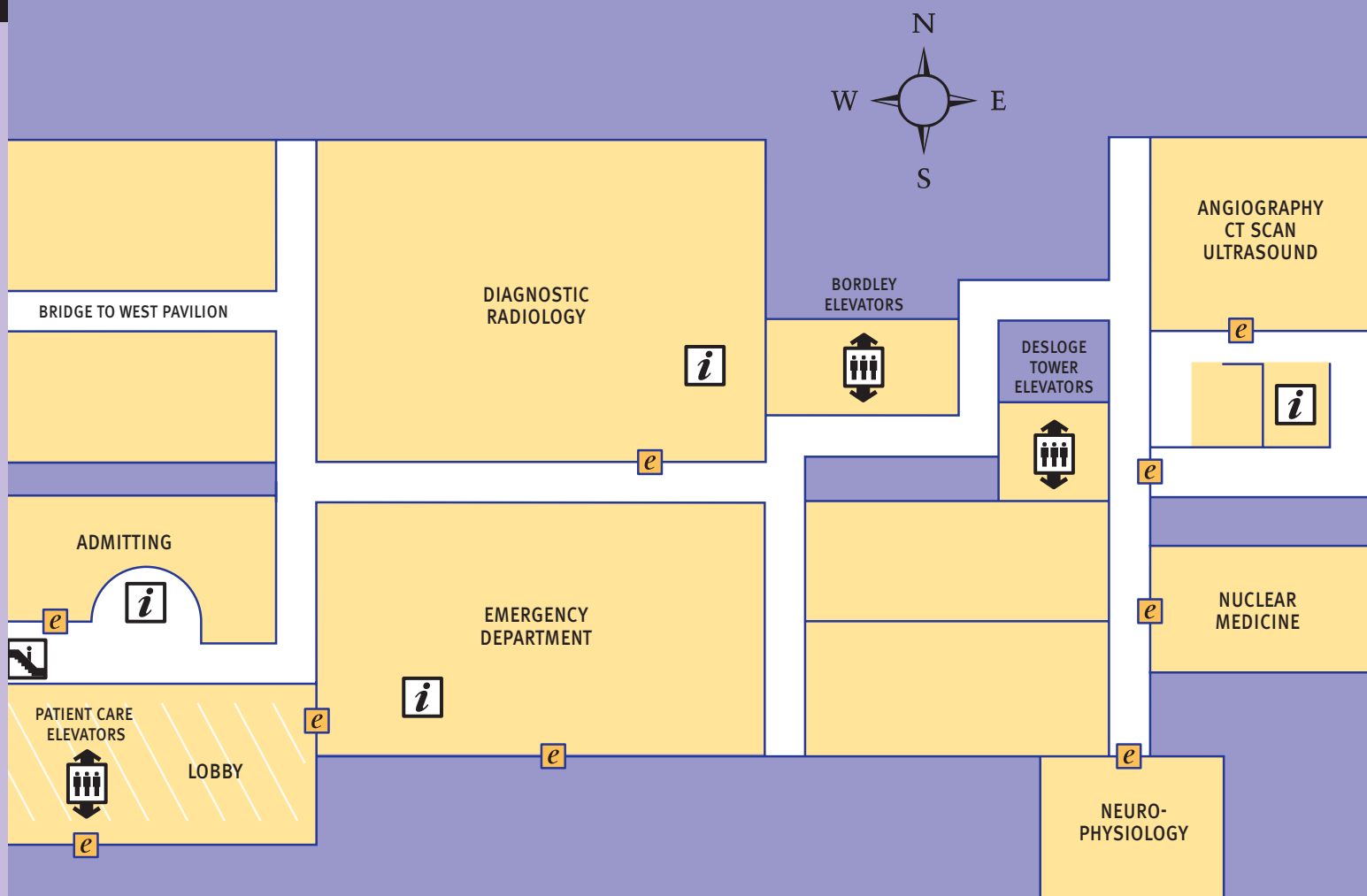
Procedures performed: autonomic nervous system test, brain stem auditory evoked potential, electromyograph (EMG), muscle biopsy, nerve conduction/EMG, nerve conduction study, quantitative sensory testing, routine EEG, sleep-deprived EEG, somatosensory evoked potential
 See 2nd floor map. To waiting area: Take Desloge Tower elevators. Turn right. Waiting area is through the double doors at the end of the hall.

Electrocardiography Laboratory (also known as EKG, Holter Lab)

Procedures performed: 24-hour EKG, 24-hour Holter, ambulatory Holter, event monitor, Holter monitor, pacemaker check over the phone, transtelephonic pacemaker monitoring, TTM (transtelephonic pacemaker monitoring)
 To lab: Take the Bordley elevators to the 9th floor. Turn left, then right. To waiting area: Take Desloge Tower elevators. Turn right. Waiting area is through the double doors at the end of the hall.

Electromyography Laboratory

See Electroencephalography Laboratory.

Electrophysiology (also known as EPS, Pacemaker Laboratory)

To lab: Take the Bordley elevators to the 12th floor. Make two lefts and through the double doors. To waiting area: Take the Bordley elevators to the 12th floor. Waiting area is straight across the elevators.

Endoscopy Suite

Procedures performed: colonoscopy, EGD (upper endoscopy), endoscopic ultrasound, ERCP, flexible sigmoidoscopy, percutaneous endoscopic gastrostomy (PEG), upper endoscopy

To lab: Take the Desloge Tower elevators to the 10th floor. Turn right. Endoscopy is straight ahead. To registration and waiting area: Take the Bordley elevators to the 10th floor. Take two lefts, then a right. Registration and waiting is on the right.

Heart Catheterization Laboratory

See Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory.

Heart Station

Procedures performed: event monitor (after business hours), Holter monitor (after 3:30 p.m.), telemetry monitors (inpatient only)

Take the Bordley elevators to the 9th floor. Make three lefts. The Heart Station is on the right.

Holter

See Electrocardiographic Monitoring.

Hemodialysis

Take the Desloge Tower elevators to the 5th floor. Turn left. Hemodialysis is straight ahead.

MRI (also known as Magnetic Resonance Imaging)

See 1st floor map.

Neurophysiology

See Electroencephalography.

Nuclear Medicine

Procedures performed: specialized stress tests and scans

See 2nd floor map. To waiting area: Take Desloge Tower elevators to the 2nd floor. Turn right. Take the second door on the left.

PET Imaging (also known as Positron Emission Tomography)

See 1st floor map.

Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PM&R)

Procedures performed: aphasia, biofeedback (constipation/incontinence), cognition, pelvic floor exercise, physical/occupational/speech therapy, pulmonary rehabilitation, pulmonary wellness (Second Wind), swallowing

See 1st floor map. (All balance, ergonomic screening, lymphedema therapy, return to work, splinting, vestibular rehab, work conditioning programs are conducted in the Orthopedic & Rehabilitation Center, no. 13, campus map.)

Psychiatric Units

Procedures performed: ECT, neuropsych testing, psychiatric referral

Take the lobby escalator up to Admitting. Follow signs to West Pavilion. Walk over bridge, down the hall and right to elevator C (level 3). Take the elevator to the 2nd floor for geriatric psychiatry unit, to 4th floor for adult acute psychiatry unit.

Pulmonary Function Lab

Procedures performed: specialized exercise tests and metabolic studies
 See 1st floor map.

Radiation Oncology

Take the Bordley elevators down to the service level. Turn right and then left. Radiation Oncology is on the left.

Stress Testing

See Echocardiography.

Ultrasound

Procedures performed: abdomen limited, aorta ultrasound, biopsy procedure with ultrasound guidance, thoracentesis ultrasound (torso – except the heart)
 See 2nd floor map. To waiting area: Take Desloge Tower elevators to the 2nd floor. Turn right. Take the first left. Follow the signs to registration.

Vascular Lab

Procedures performed: ankle-arm index (AAI), ankle-brachial index (ABI), arterial doppler, carotid doppler or duplex, digit PPG, duplex imaging, SLBP, ultrasound (upper/lower extremities, neck), venous doppler
 See 1st floor map.
